A village location

Ntsingfou is a small village of 3,000 inhabitants located 2 km south of the palace of the supreme leader, the heart of the community violated in the department of Menoua. Ntsinfeu is also one of five former villages of the kingdom Bafou. Creating Ntsingbeu is dated back to the 1740s by seven children of one mother called Ndzome of Batsingla the nearby village, according to legend.

The landscape of the Village

Although most natural forests have been felled for crops and homes, some small wood remain here and there. Around houses and fields of culture certain species commonly found in secondary forests such as eucalyptus trees kola nuts and coffee dominate. The natural vegetation is the savannah and populated grasses.



All the hillsides overlooking valleys very hydromorphic. Rivers come together to form small ponds containing fish such as tilapia and catfish. The bamboo raffia along the marshy giving a gallery forest. In these muddy rivers that people unfortunately buys into drinking water.

Because of population density and hard work, the landscape has been extensively remodeled. Indeed, almost all parcels of land are cultivated, those who do not are left fallow and used temporarily to livestock grazing. Wildlife has also been amended antelopes, buffaloes, hyenas, wolves, jackals d'entants leaving room for palm rats, porcupines, squirrels, birds and other animals little offensive.

Involvement

You will be involved in various tasks, such as:

- Weeks of family integration in Cameroon
- Weeks of language training Yemba
- Stage of ground in one of 7 institutions (**primary school, community hospital, breeding center, orphanage, training center for girls, House of Youth and Culture, Center for Fair and Sustainable Tourism**)

Other tasks you may be awarded depending on the circumstances and emergencies of the moment. A briefing will be held each morning and once a week to plan the work ahead.

We follow a program of weekly activities and weekends are free and you can relax, go to the nearest beach, or even visit Bafou and its rich cultural heritage. The center offers peace and tranquility of a country place, breathtaking views and the pleasure of hearing the roar of memorable traditions.



Accommodation

You stay in a fully equipped home or in foster care: a kitchen where you can prepare your own food, 10 rooms (capacity 20 people), a living room and a toilet. The house is equipped, as well as sheets and towels.

French and English

Requirements

You are welcome to attend (s) to join us and bring us your qualifications. You must:

- Be in good health and good physical condition
- Be available for a minimum of fifteen days
- Ability to work in teams



Constraints

If you want to participate for a period of 4 weeks or more, you must send us a letter and a CV (in French). Although not required for stays of less than 4 weeks, those documents are still welcome.

Travel Information

A transfer round trip from the airport to the center can be arranged only if you arrive on a Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday or Friday and the international airport of Douala. You MUST contact the project via e-mail or by phone at least two weeks in advance to arrange your transfer.

There is no public transport in this area and if you intend to rent a car it can be your best option. The transfer cost is \$ 50 one way and \$ 100 round trip.

If you can not / do not drive, it is possible to make arrangements with the center staff before you leave so that we pick you up at the airport and you are transported to the center.
